
















3. Transportation


By Taxi:

It is best to inform the driver to approach the gate of the **Ciudad Politécnica de la Innovación** at the *Ingeniero Fausto Elio Street*, which can be easily recognized by four flagpoles next to the gate.

By tram:

Lines 4 (blue) or 6 (purple), **the most convenient stop is Serreria**. From the tram stop walk <u>along *Ingeniero Fausto Elio Street*</u> to arrive to the entrance. See times and fares at Metro de Valencia. The same ticket of the metro is valid for the tram and vice versa.

By bus:

There are many bus lines that arrive to the CPI, but the closer bus **lines are the 93 and 98** whose stop is "*Tarongers - Fausto Elio*". The bus stop is just in front of the main entrance. To indicate you would like to get off the bus, you must press the button "stop" inside the bus. One trip cost 1.5€ and you can buy it directly at the bus (no card needed). You can buy









a *Bonobus* (10 trips) on some tobacconists and kiosks ($8.5 \in +2 \in$ card). Prices from 01/01 to 30/06 are partly funded by the Valencian Government:

By car:

You can come also by car. you may find parking areas outside the Vera campus in the zones marked in red in the picture.











4. Arriving from Valencia Airport

By Taxi

- Price: From the airport to the city centre or the UPV premises, approximately 25-30 €
- Radio Taxi Valencia: +34 963 703 333
- Teletaxi: +34 963 571 313

By Underground

There are two underground lines 3 (red) and 5 (green), which link the airport to the city centre (26 minutes to Xàtiva or Colón metro stations). You should buy a ticket for the zones ABCD that costs $3.9 \in$ plus one \in for the reusable cardboard. Check times and fares at the Metro de Valencia <u>website</u>. Moreover, the line 3-red (underground) has a connection in the Benimaclet station with lines 4 and 6 (tram).
